$$4 \text{ times } 3 = 4 \times 3 = \underline{12} \text{ balls}$$



4 groups of 2 stars in each

$$2+2+2+2=8 \text{ stars}$$

$$4 \text{ times } 2 = 4 \times 2 = 8 \text{ stars}$$



2 groups of 6 Ice-creams in each

$$6 + 6 = 12 \text{ Ice creams}$$

$$6 \text{ times } 2 = 2 \times 6 = 12 \text{ Ice-creams}$$

3 groups of 5 leaves in each

$$5 + 5 + 5 = 15 \text{ leaves}$$

$$5 \text{ times } 3 = 3 \times 5 = 15 \text{ leaves}$$

2 groups of 4 cupcakes in each

$$4 + 4 = 8 \text{ cupcakes}$$

$$4 \text{ times } 2 = 2 \times 4 = 8 \text{ cupcakes}$$

$$\text{Ans: } 6 \times 2 = 12 \text{ hands}$$

b) How many wheels do 4 cars have?

$$\text{Ans: } 4 \times 4 = 16 \text{ Wheels}$$

c) How many wings do 5 birds have?

$$\text{Ans: } 5 \times 2 = 10 \text{ wings}$$

d) How many wheels do 2 Autos have?

$$\text{Ans: } 2 \times 3 = 6 \text{ wheels}$$

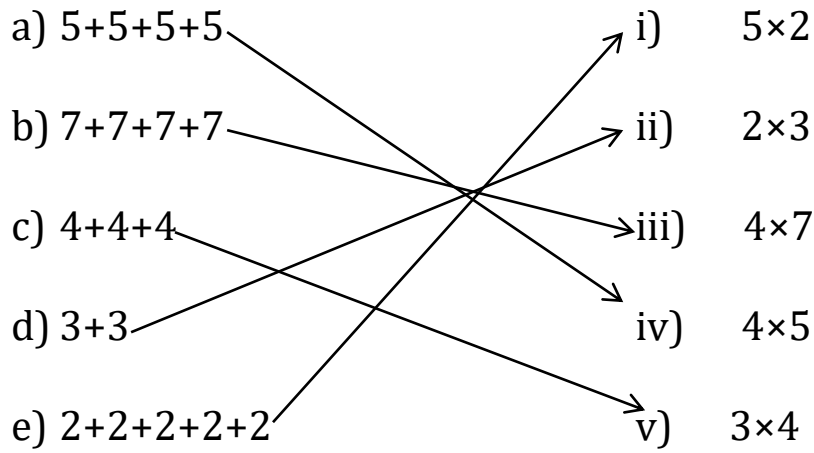
e) How many fingers are there in 3 hands?
