Articles: *The articles are the words 'a, an and the'. They define whether a noun is specific or unspecific. There are two types of articles.*

(1).The definite article (The): *'The' is called the definite article. It defines its noun as something specific.*

E.g.: This is the lake. I was talking about. (Here 'the' specifies that particular lake the subject is talking about).

(2).The Indefinite article (A, An): *'A' and 'An' are called the indefinite articles. They define their noun as something unspecific.*

*E.g.: *I am a student.*
