Adjectives: Words that describe or modify a noun or a pronoun are called adjectives.

Adjectives of Quality : Adjectives that describe the nature, colour, size age, shape, origin and material of the noun or pronoun are called adjectives of quality. They answer the question 'What kind of'.

Ex: Neetu has a lovely pouch.

Adjectives of Number : Adjectives that tell about the number of the noun are called adjectives of number. They answer the question 'How many'

Ex: There are five masks in the medical kit.

Adjectives of Quantity : Adjectives that tell about the amount of the noun are called adjectives of quantity. They answer the question 'how much'.

Hint Adjectives of quantity are used with uncountable nouns where adjectives of number are used with countable nouns.
