Adjectives: Words that describe or modify a noun or a pronoun are called adjectives.

Adjectives of Quality : Adjectives that describe the nature, colour, size age, shape, origin and material of the noun or pronoun are called adjectives of quality. They answer the question 'What kind of'.

Ex: Neetu has a lovely pouch.

Adjectives of Number : Adjectives that tell about the number of the noun are called adjectives of number. They answer the question 'How many'

Ex: There are five masks in the medical kit.

Adjectives of Quantity: Adjectives that tell about the amount of the noun are called adjectives of quantity. They answer the question 'how much'.

Hint : Adjectives of quantity are used with uncountable nouns where adjectives of number are used with countable nouns.
