- We use **and** to join sentences when they go well together or have connected ideas.
- We use the conjunction **'but'** when we join two ideas which are opposite in meaning.
- We use or to join the pairs of sentences **'or'** is used to show choice.

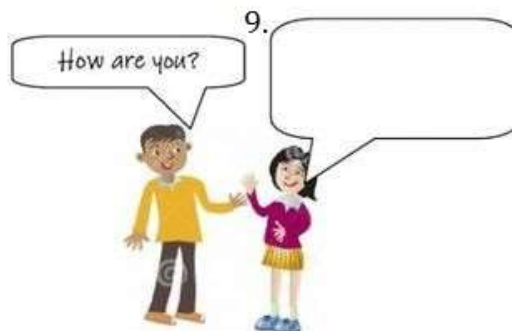
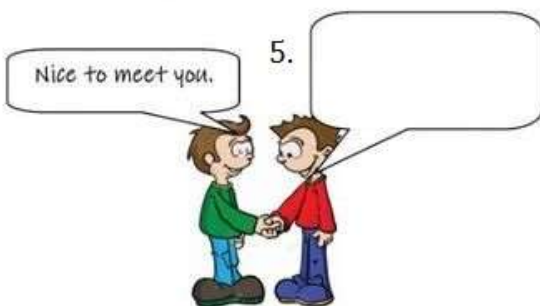
