Topic: Adverbs

Adverbs: *An adverb is a word that tells something more about a verb.*

It tells how, where and when an action happens.

E.g.: He ran quickly.

Adverbs of Manners: *Words that tells us how something happens or is done are called Adverbs of Manners.*

E.g.: Aastha sang beautifully. (How did Aastha sing? -Beautifully)

Adverbs of Time: *Words that tell us when something happens are called adverbs of time.*

*E.g.: *I will tell you tomorrow. (When will I tell you? -tomorrow)*

Adverbs of Place: *Words that tells us where something happens are called adverbs of place.*

E.g.: The party is inside the building. (Where is the party? – inside)
