Topic: Sentence -Subject & Predicate

Definition: *Each sentence is made up of two parts. The first part is called the Subject. The subject is the name of the person, place or thing that the sentence is about.*

The second part is called the predicate. The predicate says something about the subject. The first word in the predicate is verb.

E.g.: The chameleon sat on the branch.

In the above sentence, The Chameleon is the subject and sat on the branch is predicate.
