DEFINITIONS:

1. Successor: The number which comes immediately after the given number is called its successor.

E.g.: $6,78,230 = 6,78,230 + 1 = 6,78,231$

2. Predecessor: The number which comes just before a given number is called its predecessor.

Eg: $8,48,721 = 8,48,721 - 1 = 8,48,720$
