Topic: Materials That We Use







All things are made of materials. They are classified into two types:

1.Natural material: Stone, clay and metals

2.Man-made materials: Plastic, paper and glass.

Things made of Stone: Stone is a hard and heavy material. It is used to build houses, bridges and dams. Statues can also be made of stone.

Things made of Wood : Doors, windows, furniture, ships and some toys are made of wood.

Things made of Metals: Vessels, coins, motor vehicles such as cars, buses, scooters and jewellery are made of metals. Iron, copper, aluminium, brass, gold and silver are some of the most commonly used metals.

Things made of Clay: Flower pots and porcelain crockery are made of clay. Wet clay is sticky and elastic. It gets hard when dry. Potters use wet clay to make many things.

Things made of cloth : Cloth is used to make clothes, bags and covers. Cloth is made by weaving thread. Cotton, wool, silk and jute are materials used for weaving cloth.

Things made of Plastic and Glass: Plastic is a man-made material. Different kinds of plastics are made in factories.

Glass is another material that is made in factories. Bulbs, glasses, and window panes are made of glass.


