I. Verbs: A verb is a word that is used to denote an action, the condition of the subject or what is possessed by the subject

Kinds of Verbs

Transitive Verbs

[A Verb which requires an Object to complete its meaning is called a transitive Verb.]

Intransitive Verbs

[A Verb which does not require an Object to complete its meaning, but makes good sense by itself is called intransitive Verb]

Ex1: Sana likes doughnuts.

Hint: To find out the object of the verb, Ask: Whom or what received the action?

So, ask the question “ What does Sana like ?” the answer is doughnuts” so likes is a transitive verb.

Ex 2: Saket is Studying.

In this sentence, the verb is ‘is studying’ which did not take any object to make complete sense.

So, ‘is studying’ is intransitive verb.
