Topic: Noun – Common & Proper Noun

Definition:

Common Noun: *The general name of a person, place, animal or thing is a common noun.*

E.g.: 1. It is his dog.

2. They live in a city.

In sentence (1) dog is a general name for the animal and in sentence (2) city is the general name for a place.

Common nouns are not capitalized unless they begin a sentence or are part of a title.

Proper Noun: *A particular name of a person, place, animal or thing is a proper noun. They are always written in capital letter.*

E.g.: 1. His dog's name is Pluto.

2. They live in Mumbai.

In sentence (1) Pluto is a particular name of the dog and in sentence (2), Mumbai is particular name of a city.
