Topic: Noun- Countable and Uncountable

Countable Noun: *Countable nouns are those that refer to something that can be counted. They have both singular and plural forms.*

E.g.: cat/cats; box/boxes; book/books

Uncountable Noun: *Uncountable nouns are the things that we cannot count. They may be ideas or qualities or physical objects that are too small to be counted. They are used with a singular verb.*

E.g.: sugar, milk, water
