Exclamatory Sentence: *An Exclamatory sentence conveys a strong emotion and ends with an exclamation mark (!). It makes a statement (just like a declarative sentence), but it also conveys excitement, surprise or emotions.*

*E.g.: * How fast he runs!*

** I hate you!*

** What a beautiful house!*
