**ADVERBS:** An adverb is a part of speech. An adverb describes a verb, another adverb or an adjective. Adverbs answer how , where, when , how much , how often and etc... questions.

**ADVERBS OF MANNER:**

Adverbs of Manner tell us how an action is done.

Ex: Pooja sang sweetly.

In the above example, the underlined word 'sweetly' answers the question 'How did Pooja sing ? '

Hence, as the word 'sweetly' answers the question,

"How did Pooja sing ? 'Sweetly' is called adverb of manner.

- ◆ Adverbs of Manner usually end with 'ly'
- ◆ Examples of adverbs of Manner: gently, happily, hard, hastily, kindly, noisily, fast, really, rarely, rapidly, cheerfully.

## ADVERBS OF PLACE:

Adverbs of place answer the question “Where?” It describes where something happens.

Example:

1. I saw her here.

In the above example, the underlined word ‘here’ answers the question “where” i.e when you ask a question “where did you see her?”

We get the answer “here.” So here is the adverb of place in the above example.

Examples of adverbs of place:

Anywhere, down, up, under, far, nearby, indoors, out, somewhere, back, here, inside, outside, nextdoor, below, in, near, downstairs, there etc.

- ◆ Adverbs of place are usually placed after the verb.
