### Topic: Adjectives

**Adjectives:** *An adjective modifies or gives more information about a noun or pronoun. It tells about the quality, quantity, number or order of the noun that it describes.*

**Adjectives of Quality:** *It tells us about 'What kind?' of noun we are talking about.*

E.g.: The hungry fox chased a cat.

*hungry* tells us 'What kind of fox?' it is.

**Adjectives of Quantity:** *It gives answer the question 'How much?'. They mostly describe uncountable nouns.*

E.g.: There is little water to drink!

*little* answers the question 'How much water?'

**Adjectives of Number:** *It answers the question 'How many?'*

E.g.: I will be absent for six days.

*six* answers the question 'How many days?'
