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## Subject: English

### Topic: Adjectives

**Definition:** *An adjective modifies or gives more information about a noun or pronoun. It tells about the quality, quantity, number or order of the noun that it describes.*

**Adjective of quality:** *It tells us 'What kind of' noun we are talking about.*

*E.g.: Balu served a plate of delicious biryani.*

*delicious tells us 'What kind of biryani 'Balu had served.*

**Adjective of Quantity:** *It gives answer to the question 'How much'.*

*They mostly describe uncountable nouns.*

*E.g.: There is little rice in the cooker.*

*little answers 'How much rice?'*

**Adjective of Number:** *It answers the question 'How many?'. It tell about the number of the noun and is used only with countable nouns.*

*E.g.: There are five thousand books in our school library.*

*five thousand answers the question 'How many?'*

*Some adjectives can be used both as adjectives of number and adjectives of quantity. If the adjective is followed by a countable noun, it is an adjective of number and if it is followed by an uncountable noun, it is an adjective of quantity.*
