Topic: Verbs – Helping Verbs

Helping Verb: *A helping verb also known as auxiliary verb, which is used with a main verb to help express the main verb's tense, mood or voice.*

E.g.: *Peter sings well.

* Raj ate the lunch.

In these sentences the verbs 'sings' and 'ate' describe an action.

*Peter is singing well.

* Raj was eating the lunch.

In these sentences 'is' and 'was' are the helping verbs. They show the tense of the main verb sing and eat.

List of helping verbs: *Have forms (has, have - present tense, had -past tense),do forms (do, does - present tense, did - past tense), be forms(am, is, are - present tense, was ,were – past tense), may, shall, will, can or must.*
