Topic: Possessive Adjectives

Possessive Adjective: *This adjective occurs before a noun. They show possession. In other words, they indicate that the noun they refer to belongs to someone. Possessive adjectives can occur with both singular and plural nouns.*

*E.g.: * Our school is ranked first in the country.*

** Their father is in the air force.*

Possessive Adjectives: I, she, he, it, you, they, we, are subject pronouns which change in the following way to possessive adjectives.

I – my, she – her, he – his, it – its, you – your, they – there, we – ours.
